

Wagram

The growing region:

The “Donauland” wine-growing region was renamed “Wagram” in 2007. Its 2451 hectares of vineyards are divided between two quite different zones. North of the Danube and abutting the *Kamptal* on the east is the *Wagram* area, a mighty shelf of land stretching 30 km eastwards. South of the Danube are the small vineyard villages of the Tullnerfeld, as well as the historical wine city of Klosterneuburg before the gates of Vienna.

Nimmervoll winery

This winery was planned and established in Engelmansbrunn (Wagram). Here, you can taste form and function. In the modern, functional cellar Gregor Nimmervoll combines traditional family values with the modern wine-making methods of the Krems Wine School. The selected combination of a vintage can be tasted after due time in the winery’s modern tasting room. Gregor Nimmervoll remains true to himself and makes only wines that he himself would drink. Thus, the NIMM line is light for the lighter moments in life, and substantial when it’s time to get to the bottom of things. All of the robust vintages of the Nimmervoll house are multilayered and just waiting to be savoured drop by drop.
